NOTIFICATION

Whereas the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has notified six new Nagar Panchayats i.e Anni and Nirmand in District Kullu, Nerwa and Chirgaon in District. Shimla, Kandaghat in District Solan and Amb in District Una.

And whereas the Commission had decided to conduct the elections to these newly created Nagar Panchayats in near future therefore the State Election Commission in exercise of the powers vested in it under Article 243ZA Constitution of India, Section 281 of the Himachal Pradesh Municipal Act, 1994 read with Rule 26 of the Himachal Pradesh Municipal Election Rule, 2015 hereby directs special revision of the Electoral Rolls in respect of abovementioned Nagar Panchayats;

The State Election Commission further directs that the qualifying date for inclusion of names of eligible electors in the said rolls shall be 1.1.2021 as required under rule 17 (a) of the rules ibid.

The Commission further directs that the special revision of electoral rolls with 01.01.2021 as qualifying date shall also be applicable in all those Municipalities of the State where any post of the Members remained vacant in the recently held General Elections.

The final electoral rolls updated during the recently held general elections with 01.12.2020 as qualifying date shall be notified as draft electoral rolls in accordance with Rule 19 of the rules ibid. Wide publicity may be made of the qualifying date and the programme for the preparation of electoral roll through media and other means of communication.

The Electoral Registration Officers, Municipalities will appoint Revising Authorities under Rule-21 of the HP Municipal Election Rules, 2015. The claims, objections and appeals shall be received and decided even on holidays. All claims, objections etc. shall be entered in Forms 7, 8 and 9 to be maintained on the prescribed registers under Rule 22(4) of the ibid Rules.

After all the claims/objections and appeals received during the period have been decided, the Electoral Roll Registration Officer shall prepare a supplementary list- 2021 through ERMS Software and shall issue notice of final publication of electoral rolls on Form-17 as per schedule fixed by the Commission. The finally published electoral rolls shall be uploaded on the official website of the State Election Commission.

As soon as the notice of final publication is issued by the Electoral Roll Registration Officer, the intimation of the same may be sent to the Commission immediately through E-mail followed by confirmation by post. Thereafter 15 copies of the supplementary list- 2021 shall be printed. These supplementary list shall be added to the main electoral roll prepared in 2020. These electoral rolls with supplementary- 2021 shall be used in the ensuing elections.

The copies of the electoral rolls be made available for sale at the cost of Rs.10/- per page to be paid in cash against receipt. However a person interested in purchasing of electoral roll shall have to purchase full set of electoral rolls of the concerned Ward.

The relevant provisions of ibid Rules enshrined under Chapter-IV shall be adhered to strictly for the preparation of the said electoral rolls through special revision. Needless to say that the aforesaid programme should be implemented in letter and spirit. If any violation of this programme is noticed, it will be in contravention of the mandate of the Constitution of India and the relevant statutory provisions, which may lead to serious consequences in view of Section 281(4) of the Himachal Pradesh Municipal Act, 1994.
