#### **PREFACE**

The State Election Commission Himachal Pradesh has so far conducted six general elections to Panchayati Raj Institutions and Urban Local Bodies in the State. Since the system of local self government is dynamic and the status of representatives keeps on changing, it is imperative that the vacancies arising due to a variety of reasons in various Urban and Rural Local bodies of the State be filled in time, so that the people may not be deprived of their right of representation. Also, in absence of adequate representation at local level, various government schemes cannot be implemented and development work is hampered. Thus by-elections to casual vacancies throughout the State were conducted in the month of August, 2022 so that the vacancies arising on account of various reasons are filled swiftly.

This report aims to gather and document information on these by-elections in a consistent manner. This report is made keeping in mind the recurrent need of using election data by various stakeholders and I hope that this report will be helpful in achieving its desired outcome. I wish to take this opportunity to place on record appreciation for the sincerity displayed by all field officials to ensure smooth, fair and transparent conduct of these by-elections. Without their hard work and devotion to duty, it would not have been possible to conduct these elections. Special thanks are also due to the electorate and the contesting candidates for participating enthusiastically in this festival of democracy at the grass roots and making it a grand success. And of course, not to forget, the extremely knowledgeable and committed staff in the Commission Headquarters, without whose involvement and commitment, the elections would be difficult. They all deserve appreciation of the highest order.

#### 1) Preparation for the Elections:

earlier updated the electoral rolls of the Panchayati Raj Institutions of the State with 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2022 as qualifying date. In view of the decision of the Commission to conduct by-elections to fill up to date vacancies in the Panchayati Raj Institutions of the State, it was decided to update the electoral rolls of these areas with 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2022 as qualifying date so that maximum number of eligible young voters may exercise their right to franchise. The date for the final publication of electoral rolls was fixed on or before 08<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. (Annexure-I) .The total number of electors wherein by-elections were conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 was as under:-

#### 2) Preparatory Activities carried out by the Commission

#### 2.1) Directions regarding Conduct of Elections

**2.1.1**) The Commission issued detailed directions to all District Election Officers (Panchayats) regarding preliminary arrangements, arrangement of ballot boxes, nominations, disclosure of specified information, deposit of amount received from the candidates and others during elections, ballot papers, counting arrangements, maintenance of Law and Order, enforcement of the Model Code of Conduct etc vide letter dated 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2020 (Annexure-II).

#### 3) Details of Casual Vacancies

**3.1**) There were a total 221 casual vacancies in the State across different Panchayati Raj Institutions. Post wise break up of these vacancies was as under:

#### 4) Election Programme

4.1) After the final publication of the electoral rolls, the Commission issued the election programme on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2022 (Annexure-III). As per election programme, nominations were scheduled for 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. The scrutiny of nominations was directed to be carried out on 28th July, 2022, while withdrawal of nominations was permitted till 30th July, 2022. The list of contesting candidates was prepared and affixed on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 immediately after the time for withdrawal was over. The list of polling stations was notified by 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022. The poll was scheduled to be held on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. The Counting of votes for the posts of Ward Members, Up-Pradhan and Pradhan of Gram Panchayats was undertaken on the date of poll immediately after the close of poll at Gram Panchayat

Headquarters. Counting of votes for members Panchayat Samiti and Member Zila Parishad took place on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 at respective Development Block Headquarters. The results of elections of Ward Members, Up-Pradhan and Pradhan of Gram Panchayat were declared on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022, while the result of elections to Panchayat Samiti Members was declared at Block Headquarters and of Member Zila Parishad at District Headquarters on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.

**4.2)** Election to Pradhan Gram Panchayat Sainj: In the year 2020-21, during the general elections to Panchayati Raj Institutions in the State, the post of Pradhan Gram Panchayat Sainj Development Block Theog, District Shimla was notified as reserved for Other Backward Classes. But a CWP No. 6352 of 2020 was filed in the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh with the prayer that there is not enough population of OBC in the said Panchayat to justify reservation for OBC. Accordingly elections could not be held along with other Panchayat elections. DC Shimla de-reserved the post after some enquiries and obtaining field reports. After the de-reservation, the Commission issued programme on 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 to fill up the post of Pradhan Gram Panchayat along with by-election scheduled to be conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 for several other casual vacancies across the State. But again a CWP No. 3490 of 2022 was filed in the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh with the prayer to fill up the post from OBC Category. Accordingly, Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh issued order on 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 to conduct elections for the post of Pradhan afresh from amongst Other Backward Classes category candidates. In pursuance to the order of Hon'ble High Court, the Commission issued a fresh separate programme on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 and conducted the poll on 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 and the result was also declared on 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 in the evening. All data/figures mentioned in this report include election to Pradhan GP Sainj.

#### 5) <u>Model Code of Conduct</u>

**5.1**) In order to conduct free, fair and independent elections, the Commission enforced the Model Code of Conduct as notified by this Commission on 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2020 for the guidance and observance by all concerned vide Notification dated 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 (Annexure-IV). Directions were issued to all Election related officers and officials to ensure strict compliance with the Model code of conduct.

#### **Report on the Elections:**

#### **6.1) Nominations:**

- **6.1.1**) A total of 4 nominations were filed for the single Zila Parishad Seat i.e. Jhakhri Ward No. 2 Zila Parishad in Shimla till the close of nominations. After scrutiny and withdrawal, 3 candidates were left in the fray.
- **6.1.2**) 34 nominations were filed for the 6 Panchayat Samiti seats in districts of Chamba, Mandi, Shimla, Solan and Una. After scrutiny and withdrawal, 24 candidates were left in the fray.
- **6.1.3**) For the 14 posts of Gram Panchayat Pradhan contested across the State, 74 nominations were filed till the close of nominations. After scrutiny and withdrawal, 54 candidates were left in the fray.
- **6.1.4**) 18 posts of Gram Panchayat Up-Pradhan were to be contested across the State. 81 nominations were filed till the close of nominations. After scrutiny and withdrawals, only 40 candidates were left in the fray.
- **6.1.5**) In addition to above, 182 ward member seats were to be contested across the State. Nominations were received for 174 wards and a total of 272 nominations were filed till the close of nominations. After scrutiny and withdrawals, 96 candidates were left in the fray.

However no nominations were received for 8 Wards. Out of these 8 wards, 3 wards i.e. Ward Member, Gram Panchayat Kasauli, Development Block Dharampur, Distt. Solan, Ward Member, Gram Panchayat Urla, Development Block Drang and Ward Member, Gram Panchayat Luhakhar, Development Block Balh, Distt. Mandi remained vacant after the ensuing by-elections although electors of these wards had elected their representatives during the general elections held in January 2021. However, electors of one ward each of Gram Panchayat Gharna and Chilga, Development Block Dehra, and three wards of Gram Panchayat Pargour Development Block Rait are boycotting the election process since January 2021 due to certain grievances. The State Election Commission, Himachal Pradesh vide its letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2021, 03<sup>rd</sup> February, 2022, 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 and 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 had requested the Government of HP to carry out an awareness campaign in these

wards and persuade the residents of these wards to participate in the grass root level democratic process but the impasse still continues.

#### **6.2)** <u>Unopposed Election</u>

**6.2.1**) Out of the 6 Panchayat Samiti Wards going for election, one member of Takoli ward of Panchayat Samiti Development Block Bangana, District Una was elected unopposed. Similarly, out of 18 Vacancies of Panchayat Up-Pradhan, 5 Up-Pradhans were elected Unopposed. In addition to this, out of 174 Panchayat Ward Members for which nominations were filed, 133 members were elected unopposed. Thus 76.44% of the total vacancies of Panchayat Ward Members were filled up with consensus and no voting was necessary.

#### **Polling Stations**

**6.3.1**) A total of 310 polling booths were set up for by-elections to Panchayati Raj Institutions of Himachal Pradesh. A detail of district wise polling stations is mentioned in the table below:-


#### **6.4) Voter Turnout**

**6.4.1**) Out of the 82370 voters registered for these by-elections, 48929 came out to cast their vote, which means a 59.40% voter turnout. Out of the total votes polled, 24235 were accounted for by female voters, contributing to 49.53% of the total votes polled. Highest polling took place in District Kinnaur with 80.83% voting, while the lowest voter turnout was 45.37% in district Shimla, where election to one post of Zila Parishad was held. The district wise details of total voters as well as the number of votes cast by male and female voters is given in the next table:

#### **6.5)** Educational Background of Elected Candidates:

- **6.5.1**) The winning candidate from the sole Zila Parishad seat which went to poll is a Senior Secondary School pass-out (12<sup>th</sup> pass). Out of the 6 Panchayat Samiti Ward members elected, one member is a Post-Graduate, one member is a graduate, 2 members are senior secondary school pass outs (12<sup>th</sup> pass) one is a matriculate (10<sup>th</sup> pass) while one member has not completed his matriculation.
- **6.5.2**) Out of 14 elected Gram Panchayat Pradhans, one pradhan has not completed matriculation. 7 pradhans are matriculates while 3 pradhans have completed their senior secondary schooling. One elected GP pradhan is a graduate while two of them are Post-Graduates.
- **6.5.3**) Out of the 18 Gram Panchayat Up-Pradhans who were elected, 3 of them have not completed their matriculation. However 9 of them have done their matriculation, while another 4 Up-pradhans have completed their senior secondary schooling. Remaining 2 elected Up Pradhans are Graduates.
- **6.5.4**) 174 Panchayat Ward member vacancies attracted nominations and were contested. 46 of the elected ward members have not completed their matriculation, 74 GP ward members are matriculates while another 42 have completed their senior secondary schooling. 9 of the elected Ward members are graduates, while another 3 are post-graduate.
- **6.5.5**) Out of the total 213 casual vacancies filled, 42.7% seats are filled by matriculates while 24.4% seats are filled by members who have completed their senior secondary schooling. However 23.9% of the elected members have not completed their matriculation. Only 6.1% are graduates and 2.8% are Post Graduates.




Figure 2: Educational Background of Elected Candidates

#### **6.6) Age Profile of Elected Candidates:**

- **6.6.1**) The age of the sole elected Zila Parishad member is between 41 to 50 years. Out of the 6 Panchayat Samiti members, age of 3 members is between 41-50 years of age. One Panchayat Samiti member is between 21-30 years of age. Of the remaining two, one member is between 31-40 years of age while the other is between 51-60 years of age.
- **6.6.2**) Out of 14 elected Gram Panchayat Pradhans, 7 pradhans are aged between 41-50 years, 4 pradhans have their age between 31-40 years and the age of another 2 pradhans falls between 51-60 years. Only one GP pradhan is more than 60 years of age.
- **6.6.3**) Out of the 18 Gram Panchayat Up-Pradhans, 7 are aged between 31-40 years, 6 have their age between 41-50 years and 3 Up-Pradhans are aged between 51-60 years. Only one Up-Pradhan is aged between 21-30 years while one elected Up-Pradhan is more than 60 years of age.
- **6.6.4)** Out of the 174 elected Gram Panchayat ward members, 62 fall in the age bracket between 41-50 years & 42 have their age between 31-40 years. 34 of them are aged between 51-60 years, 19 members are between 21-30 years of age and 17 ward members are more than 60 years old.
- **6.6.5**) Overall, out of the 213 elected members, 37.1% of the representatives belong to the age group between 41-50 years, 25.4% are aged between 31-40 years, while another 18.8% are of age between 51-60 years. Elected members belonging to 21-30 years age group and more than 60 years old have the least representation, which is around 9 percent each.

#### 6.7) Results and Victory Margin

**6.7.1)** Counting of votes with respect to Pradhans, Up-Pradhan and Ward Members was undertaken on 10.08.2022 on the day of poll itself, whereas counting of votes with respect to member Panchayat Samiti and member Zila Parishad was undertaken on 12.08.2022

**6.7.2**) There was by-election for one member of Zila Parishad Shimla for Ward No. 2 Jhakhri wherein victory margin was 472 votes. Out of 6 Panchayat Samiti Members, one member was elected unopposed, 1 candidate won by a margin of less than 10 votes, 2 won by margin of votes between 10-100 and 2 candidates won by more than 100 votes. Among the 14 Gram Panchayat Pradhans vacancies where elections were held, one candidate won by less than 10 votes, 8 candidates won by margin of votes between 10-100 and 5 Gram Panchayat Pradhan

won by margin greater than 100 votes. For the 18 vacancies of Gram Panchayat Up-Pradhan, 5 were elected unopposed, whereas polling was held for 13 seats. One candidate won by less than 10 votes, 5 candidates won by margin of votes between 10-100 and 7 candidates won by margin of votes more than 100. For 182 vacancies of Gram Panchayat Ward Member, 133 were elected unopposed and for 8 seats no nominations were filed. Out of the 41 seats wherein elections were held, 15 candidates won by less than 10 votes, 25 candidates won by margin of votes between 10-100 and only one candidate won by more than 100. Margin of victory for different posts are given in the table below:-

**6.8)** Recount of Votes: Recount of votes was carried out for 2 wards of Panchayat Samiti (One ward each in Panchayat Samiti Rohru of District Shimla and Dharampur of District Mandi) and the result in both the wards remained unaltered after recount.

#### 7) By-Elections to Urban Local Body:

**7.1**) In addition to above, Ward No. 5 in Purana Bazar of Nagar Panchayat Karsog, District Mandi was vacant due to resignation of the member. The Commission issued Election Programme to conduct by-election to the said ward on 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 (Annexure-V). As per election programme, nominations were scheduled to be filed on 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. The scrutiny of nominations was directed to be carried out on 28th July, 2022, while withdrawal of nominations was permitted till 30th July, 2022. The list of contesting candidates was prepared and affixed on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 immediately after the time for withdrawal was over. The list of polling stations was notified by 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022. The poll was scheduled to be held on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 between 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM. The Counting of

votes for the posts of Member Nagar Panchayat was undertaken on the date of poll immediately after the close of poll at Nagar Panchayat Headquarters. The winning candidate is 68 years old and has studied up to Senior Secondary School. The results of elections of Member Nagar Panchayat were declared on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 wherein victory margin was 39 votes.

#### 8) General Election to Municipal Corporation Shimla:-

- **8.1**) After the enactment of 74th Amendment in the Constitution of India, the 6<sup>th</sup> General Election to Municipal Corporation Shimla was due before 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. The Commission issued programme for Delimitation and Reservation of wards of Municipal Corporation Shimla on 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2022 (Annexure-VI). The delimitation of wards was scheduled to be finalized on or before 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 and reservation was to be done on or before 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. The Commission issued directions to Deputy Commissioner-cum-Returning Officer Shimla on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2022 (Annexure-VII) to fix and publish the polling stations in respect of all wards of Municipal Corporation Shimla on or before 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. The appeals against the orders of the Deputy Commissioner were dismissed by the Divisional Commissioner Shimla vide his orders dated 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. Accordingly, the Deputy Commissioner Shimla finalized the delimitation of wards vide his orders dated 9<sup>th</sup>, March, 2022 (Annexure-VIII). Accordingly, the Commission notified the delimitation of wards for Municipal Corporation Shimla in the Official gazette on 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 (Annexure-IX).
- **8.2**) In the meantime, two CWPs were filed in the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh where in one of the petitions filed by Ms. Simi Nanda delimitation of Nabha, Phagli and Tutikandi Wards was challenged, and in another petition filed by Sh. Rajeev Thakur, delimitation of Summerhill and Boileuganj wards was challenged. On 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh ordered to maintain the status quo in respect of wards of Municipal Corporation Shimla. On 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 the Commission filed an application under Section 151 of CPC before the Hon'ble High Court seeking clarification/modification in the stay order, with the request to allow the Commission to go ahead with the delimitation/election process qua other wards where no challenge had been made against the delimitation order, or in the alternative sought vacation/modification of stay order. But the Commission's request did not find favour with the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh.

- **8.3**) On 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 the Commission received a judgement pronounced by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 278 of 2022 titled as Suresh Mahajan Vs State of Madhya Pradesh, wherein it was directed that owing to the Constitutional mandate, conduct of elections to install the newly elected body in concerned local cell of Government cannot brook delay. On 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 the Commission filed another application under Section 151 of CPC before the Hon'ble High Court placing on record the judgement passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Suresh Mahajan Vs State of Madhya Pradesh.
- **8.4**) On 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2022 the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh disposed off both the petitions and directed the Deputy Commissioner Shimla to hear the objections filed by the petitioners afresh in accordance with the law. On 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 the Deputy Commissioner, Shimla passed order with regard to delimitation of Nabha and Summerhill wards. On 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 the Commission filed a caveat before the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh with the request that stay may not be granted in this matter if the earlier writ petitioners approaches the Hon'ble High Court, keeping in view the orders by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Suresh Mahajan Vs State of Madhya Pradesh. On 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. Both the objectors filed appeals before the Divisional Commissioner, Shimla. On 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 the Divisional Commissioner, Shimla disposed off both the appeals.
- **8.5**) On the same day i.e. 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, the Commission issued programme for updating the electoral rolls in respect of 5 wards so that elections to Municipal Corporation, Shimla may be conducted as soon as possible because the term of elected body of Municipal Corporation Shimla had already expired on 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2022.
- **8.6**) On 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, Ms. Simi Nanda and Sh. Rajeev Thakur filed CWPs No. 4574 and 4579 respectively, again challenging the delimitation of Nabha, Phagli, Tutikandi, Summerhill and Boileuganj wards. On 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Hon'ble High Court again granted the stay. On 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 the Commission filed an application before the Hon'ble High Court to vacate the stay granted in the above mentioned CWPs and allow the Commission to continue with the preparation of electoral rolls in these 5 wards. The matter was listed on 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2022 and the Hon'ble High Court directed the matter to be listed again on 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. The matter was listed on 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 when the learned Advocate General requested the Hon'ble Court to adjourn the matter. Accordingly the Hon'ble Court adjourned the matter and ordered to list the matter after two weeks.

**8.7**) In the meantime, the Commission approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India through Special Leave Petitions, which were registered on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 in the registry of the Hon'ble Apex Court. Hon'ble Supreme Court of India heard the matter on 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 and ordered as under:-

"that in terms of the orders which are presently under challenge, the matter had appeared before the High Court on 16.08.2022 but at the request of learned Advocate General, the matter was adjourned for two weeks.

In view of these circumstances, we list these special leave petitions on 26.09.2022

In the meantime, we request the High Court to consider taking up the matter as early as possible in accordance with law."

- **8.8**) Accordingly, the State Election Commission mentioned the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter and the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh pleased to heard the matter on 21.09.2022. Hon'ble High Court has again remanded back the delimitation order passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Shimla to consider it again in accordance of law.
- **8.9**) In view of repeated litigations and remanding back the delimitation order in respect of above mentioned five wards of Municipal Corporation Shimla, the Commission is not in a position to prepare the Electoral Rolls of these wards and conduct the elections to Municipal Corporation Shimla.

#### **8.10**) The Commission would like to emphasize the following points:

- The residents of the Gram Panchayats, who are boycotting the elections, need to be counselled & persuaded at the level of Government to participate in the democratic process and their grievances need to be resolved expeditiously through pro-active stakeholder discussions.
- 2. The elections to the Municipal Commission Shimla cannot be conducted by the Commission in spite of its best efforts, unless the various legal challenges to the delimitation of Municipal Corporation Shimla are settled.

3. The elections to Legislative Assembly of the State are also due in the last quarter of this year and the Election Commission of India (ECI) has started preparations in this regard. The electoral rolls of Assembly Constituencies are scheduled to be finally notified on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 and thereafter ECI can enforce Model Code of Conduct at any time. Since election machinery is the same therefore elections to Municipal Corporation Shimla can only be conducted after the process for elections to constitute Legislative Assembly of the State is over.

CONDUCT OF ELECTION TO PANCHAYATI RAJ

INSTITUTIONS -- DIRECTIONS THEREOF.

Sir,

I am directed to convey for your guidance and compliance the following directions for ensuring proper, timely and smooth conduct of general elections to Panchayati Raj Institutions of all Districts except Development Block Keylong of District Lahaul&Spiti to be held as per programme issued by the Commission.

- Programme for the conduct of general elections-2020 vide Notification dated 21.12.2020. You have to make all preparatory arrangements within a short time. It is presumed that the list of staff to be deployed for this purpose has been prepared by now. If not, the same would need to be initiated immediately. You are advised to chalk-out a programme for imparting training to the Returning Officers/Assistant Returning Officers who shall be responsible for receipt of nominations, scrutiny of nomination papers, preparing list of contesting candidates, allotment of symbols and finally counting and declaration of results. The polling personnel may be given at least three rehearsals including the day fixed for collection of material for polling.
- 2. **ARRANGEMENT FOR BALLOT BOXES:-** It is presumed that by now you may have made the arrangements for collection of ballot boxes from State of Uttarakhand and

Rajasthan as intimated to you by the Commission vide its letter no. SEC(F)10-3/2020-5478 and 5493, dated 7<sup>th</sup> December, 2020.

There are two sizes of ballot boxes therefore, while distributing ballot boxes care should be taken that bigger boxes are provided to the Panchayats where numbers of electors are comparatively higher, smaller boxes can be used for Panchayat Samiti and Zila Parishad elections as two ballot papers pertaining to these offices will be inserted in one box and three ballot papers pertaining to Gram Panchayats will be inserted in one box therefore, bigger box should be used for the elections of Gram Panchayats.

Nominations for the office of Ward Member, Up-Pradhan and NOMINATION: 3. Pradhan of Gram Panchayat shall be received at the Panchayat headquarters, for Members of Panchayat Samiti at the Tehsil/Block Headquarter and for Members of ZilaParishad at the Sub-Divisional/District Headquarters as the case may be. The choice of officers to be appointed as Returning Officers/Assistant Returning Officers for the conduct of elections is left to the best judgment of District Election Officers (Panchayat). However, Assistant Returning Officers may be of a reasonable rank such as Principal/Headmaster/Lecturer of Government Senior Secondary School/Govt. High School/Govt. Middle School and Assistant Engineer/Junior Engineer/Extension Officer, etc. Since, this task involves great responsibility and need to be handled with circumspection and knowledge, an Official appointed on election duty should normally be deployed in a Panchayat other than the one which he belongs to or where he is currently stationed but should be within the same block. The Returning Officers/Assistant Returning Officers would be responsible for counting of votes also; therefore, they should be required to fully acquaint themselves with the relevant provisions of the Acts and Rules of the subject. The appointment of Returning Officers/ Assistant Returning Officers / Presiding Officers/Polling Officers may be confirmed to the Commission as soon as the same are made.

Presiding Officers and Polling Officers may be classified on the basis of scale of pay/grade pay, their post and rank. As far as possible, Gazetted Officers be deployed as Presiding Officers failing which officials who is working in supervisory capacity only may be deployed as Presiding Officers. The Presiding Officers should be of higher scale/grade in comparison to other Polling Officers of a polling party.

- 4. DISCLOSURE OF SPECIFIED INFORMATION: As you are aware that the Commission has framed Regulations namely "The Himachal Pradesh Panchayats and Municipalities Elections (Disclosure of Specified information by the Candidate) Regulations, 2004", according to which every candidate seeking election to the office of Member, Up-Pradhan and Pradhan of a Gram Panchayat shall submit the specified information in the Annexure-I as per rule 5 of the said regulation in the form of an affidavit or a declaration. Every person seeking election to Panchayat Samiti and ZilaParishad shall submit the same information, as per rule 4 read with sub-rule 2 of the regulation, in the form of an affidavit duly attested by Magistrate or Notary Public or Oath Commissioner. Forms in respect of Annexure-I, already stand supplied to you and is required to be issued alongwith the Nomination Form to the contesting candidates. Therefore, please ensure that the said Annexure-I is attached to each nomination paper so that every contesting candidate should get complete set of nomination papers.
- 5. DEPOSIT OF AMOUNT RECEIVED ON ACCOUNT OF VARIOUS RECEIPTS DURING THE ELECTIONS: While imparting the training to Returning Officers/Assistant Returning Officers, you are requested to bring it to their notice that while discharging their duty as Returning Officer/Assistant Returning Officer they will receive various amounts such as on account of sale of voter lists, amount of forfeited security and amount on account of challenging of identity of a voter etc. The amount so received shall be deposited in the following Receipt Head of Accounts:

Major Head: 0070-Other Administrative Services-02-Election 101-Sale proceeds for election Forms and documents-02-Sale proceeds for election Forms and documents by State Election Commission.

As far as security money is concerned, the Assistant Returning Officer shall deposit the forfeited security money with the Returning Officer concerned immediately and it will be responsibility of Returning Officer only to deposit the forfeited security money in the Govt. Treasury immediately after receipt of such amount from Assistant Returning Officer in the following receipt Head:

Major Head: 0070-Other Administrative Services-02-Election 104-Fee fines foreitures-02-Fee fine forfeiture by State Election Commission.

Any miscellaneous amount received during the election shall be deposited in the following receipt head:-

Major Head: 0070-Other Administrative Services-02-Election 800-other receipt-03 Misc. receipt by State Election Commission.

The Returning Officer will send all the Challans in original alongwith used and unused receipt books issued to him and a summary of amount received (receipt book wise) to the Districts Election Officer (Panchayat) and retain a copy of the same with him for his record. The proforma for sending summary is as under:

Note: Even if no receipt is issued from a receipt book it has to be mentioned in the summary of receipt book.

ballot papers under rule 52. Under Rule 42, there shall be no choice of symbol i.e. symbols shall be allotted according to the symbols approved and notified by the Commission to the contesting candidates against their names as they appear in the list of the contesting candidates in alphabetical order. The name of the contesting candidates shall be written in hand on the ballot papers with a ball point pen legibly so that there is no confusion among the electors. The order of the names on ballot papers shall be the same as they appear in the list of contesting candidates. This is a massive exercise and required to be done with utmost care. The Returning Officers / Astt. Returning Officers will select suitable officials to do the job at the block headquarter.

As you are aware that option of "NOTA" "उपरोक्त में से कोई नहीं" will also be made available on the ballot paper. For this purpose the Commission has already supplied you

sufficient number of NOTA stamps and black ink stamp pads. Therefore, you would require one block extra on the ballot paper than the number of contesting candidates to apply "NOTA" stamp in black ink. While applying the stamp on ballot paper, care must be taken that it is applied within the border of last block of the ballot paper. For example, if there are five candidates for a particular office you will keep six blocks on ballot papers. The sixth block will be used for application of NOTA stamp and the remaining portion of ballot papers after the NOTA option shall be detached with the help of metal rule leaving behind the shaded portion at the bottom.

Please keep in mind that there are maximum ten symbols printed on the ballot papers. If there are ten contesting candidates for any office, you would require ballot paper with eleven blocks i.e. ten blocks for candidates and one for NOTA. Therefore, after the time of withdrawal of candidature is over, if there are ten or more than ten candidates for any office the Returning Officer will immediately inform the District Election Officer (Panchayat) name of the post alongwith number of electors so that adequate number of ballot papers could be supplied to you by the Commission. This information must reach the District Election Officer (Panchayat) at once through quickest mode who will inform the Commission at once.

The number of symbols printed on ballot paper for members of Gram Panchayats are six symbols and ten symbols. Therefore while issuing ballot for members of Gram Panchayat care should be taken that where there are five contesting candidates ballot papers with six symbols may be provided as sixth block will be used for "NOTA""उपरोक्त में से कोई नहीं" and where number of contesting candidates is six or more ballot paper printed with 10 symbols may be issued.

The gap between the date of withdrawal and the date of poll is ten days. Therefore, it has to be ensured that the writing of the names of the contesting candidates on the ballot papers is completed within a maximum of six days under the personal supervision of the concerned Returning Officer/Assistant Returning Officer. The Commission has now changed the colour scheme of ballot papers to be used in ensuing election. The following colour scheme of ballot paper has been prescribed for the entire State except District Kinnaur, Development Block Kaza of District LahaulSpiti and Pangi and Bharmour of District Chamba:

- 1. Member G.P. White
- 2. Up-Pradhan G.P. Yellow

3. Pradhan Light Green

4. Member P.S. Pink

5. Member Z.P. Light Blue

The colour scheme for District Kinnaur, Development Block Kaza of District LahaulSpiti and Pangi and Bharmour of District Chamba will remain the same as was fixed during the general elections held in the year 2015 as these Districts / Development Block have been issued ballot papers of old stock printed in the year 2015. The colour scheme for these areas will be as under:

1. Member G.P. Light Blue

2. Up-Pradhan White

3. Pradhan G.P. Yellow

4. Member P.S. Light Green

5. Member Z.P. Pink

Needless to add, any lapse in the preparation of ballot papers will nullify the entire election process. Therefore, you are advised to carry out the work of preparation of ballot papers with utmost care and sense of responsibility and ensure that the persons engaged for the purpose are discharging their duty with a sense of responsibility.

- 7. COUNTING ARRANGEMENTS: Although, the Panchayat elections are expected to be peaceful, still in order to maintain law and order and peace, adequate security arrangements shall have to be made. The pattern of deployment of Police force and Home Guards at each Polling Station and at the counting centers is left to the discretion of the District Election Officer (Panchayat) who will do the needful in consultation with the Superintendent of Police of the concerned districts. In case of sensitive polling stations, additional force may be deployed. Similarly, security arrangements in the Block Headquarters, where counting of votes for the members of the Panchayat Samiti and Zila Parishad shall have to be ensured in order to maintain law and order.
- **8. MAINTENANCE OF LAW AND ORDER:** The Secretary (Home) and Director General of Police have been requested to make available adequate force according to realistic projection of requirements by the District Election Officers (Panchayat)-cum-Deputy Commissioners in consultation with the Superintendent of Police of the Districts. Assessment

of requirement of police force and Home Guards may be done by you'in consultation with Superintendent of Police of your Districts. After identifying, Polling Stations are required to be classified as "sensitive" or "hyper-sensitive". The number of security personnel to be deployed for maintaining law and order at the sensitive stations will be suitably increased. Utmost care should be taken before classifying a polling station as sensitive. This exercise may be undertaken in consultation with the Superintendent of Police of your District.

The list of polling stations be categorized "sensitive" or "hyper-sensitive" and the quantum of force to be deployed may be intimated to the Commission immediately.

- 9. **POLLING STATIONS**: Separate Polling station has to be established for each ward of a Gram Panchayat. Care should be taken to see that polling stations established for different wards should, as far as possible, be at equal distance for the electors of the area. Polling Stations for a group of wards should be established at the Panchayat headquarters, which will also facilitate counting of votes. The buildings in which polling stations are being located should be inspected by a gazetted officer (to be recommended by you) before taking a final decision. While fixing the polling stations instructions issued by the Commission vide its letter No. SEC-16-2/2011-4820-4831 dated 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 may be kept in view. The polling station may not be located in a police station, hospital or a place having sectarian or religious significance. As far as possible, the polling station shall be located in a Govt. /Semi-Govt. buildings and where no such building is available, the polling station may be located in a temporary structure of adequate strength. The number of polling Stations set up in each block may be intimated to the Commission immediately.
- 10. **MOVEMENT PROGRAMME:** Movement programme for the polling parties should be prepared separately well in advance so that there is no cause for any confusion in the minds of the officials deputed for the purpose. Arrangement of vehicles such as buses and jeeps, wherever needed, has also to be done in advance. The Govt. of H.P. vide its notification no. PCH-HA (4)15/2000 dated 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2000 has delegated the powers of requisitioning of vehicles conferred on the State Government under Section 160-A, 160-B, and 160-C of the H.P Panchayati Raj (Amendment) Act, 2000 (Act. No. 18 of 2000), to the Deputy Commissioner within their respective Districts. The District Election Officer (Panchayat) may hire private vehicles only in extreme urgency in case Govt. vehicle are not

available at that point of time. Needless to say that in the use of vehicles utmost economy may be ensured.

- 11. **RETURN OF NON-CONSUMABLE ITEMS:-** Out of the material to be supplied to the polling parties some items mentioned below are non-consumable. Therefore, these items should be received after completion of poll. The Returning Officer/Assistant Returning Officer will not relieve the polling parties until the following items are received back:
  - Ballot boxes
  - 2. Self Inking pad
  - 3. Presiding Officer Seal
  - 4. Rubber Seal for marking Ballot paper
  - 5. Distinguishing mark seal
  - 6. Material for voting Compartment
  - 7. Metal rule for detaching ballot paper and pusher
  - 8. Needle (Sua)
  - 9. Cup for setting indelible ink.
  - 10. Gunny bags.
  - 11. NOTA Seal

Besides these RO/ARO Hand Books and Returning Officer seals may also be received from the concerned Returning Officer/Assistant Returning Officer.

12. COUNTING CENTRE: The counting of votes for the office of Member, Up-Pradhan and Pradhan of a Gram Panchayat will be done at the Panchayat Headquarters on the day of the poll after the close of poll. Once the poll is closed, the ballot boxes from other polling stations shall be brought to the counting centre alongwith the used/sealed ballot boxes of the Panchayat Samiti and ZilaParishad. All efforts should be made to commence counting as soon as possible on the same day. The Police personnel and the Home Guards on duty at that polling station shall accompany the polled ballot boxes to the counting centre in order to ensure absolute security of the used ballot boxes. The polled ballot boxes pertaining to Panchayat Samiti and ZilaParishad shall be transported to Block Headquarter. The District Election Officer (Panchayat) shall ensure that the polled ballot boxes may be safely transported to the Block Headquarter immediately after close of poll. Foolproof security

arrangements for transporting these boxes to the Block Headquarter may be ensured. If there is any security threat to ballot boxes during transportation, the District Election Officers may take decision to avoid night journey. In such eventuality adequate security arrangement for the safety of ballot boxes at Panchayat Headquarter may be made and these may be transported to the Block Headquarter next morning.

Since the elections are to be held during the winter season when the days are short, adequate lighting arrangements at the counting centers shall have to be made. In case electricity is not available or electric supply is known to be erratic in any counting centre, petromax lamps/generators / emergency light have to be arranged. Counting of votes in candle light is not permissible. As alternative only petromax lamps/generator / emergency light may be made available in the Block Offices and same may be hired. Police personnel/Home Guards on duty at the different polling stations in the Panchayat are required to remain on duty at the Panchayat Headquarter during the period of counting as well as up to the time of declaration of the results for maintaining law and order. In case used ballot boxes for Panchayat Samiti and ZilaParishad have to be kept at the Panchayat Headquarters, the police and Home Guard personals shall also remain there for night duty.

Counting at the Block Headquarter in respect of Panchayat Samiti Members and Zila Parishad Members shall be undertaken as per programme issued in this behalf. If counting is likely to continue till late night, adequate lighting arrangements and sufficient police force for maintaining law and order shall have to deployed.

- 13. MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT AND ITS OBSERVANCE: With a view to maintain a healthy and peaceful atmosphere during the election period, which would be conducive for ensuring a free and fair election, the Commission has formulated a Model Code of Conduct for the guidance of political parties, candidates and others. It should be impressed upon to all concerned that Model Code of Conduct should not be violated at any stage and you are also requested to ensure that in no circumstances Model Code of Conduct is violated. Since the elections are not being held in Keylong, Development Block of District Lahaul & Spiti, therefore, Model Code of Conduct shall not be applicable in the said Block.
- 14. PROHIBITION OF PUBLIC MEETING: Section 158-B of the Himachal Pradesh Panchayati Raj Act provides that during the period of forty-eight hours ending with the

hour fixed for the conclusion of poll no person shall convene, hold, attend, join or address any public meeting or procession in connection with an election or display to the public any election matter by means of cinematography, television or other similar apparatus. It further provides that no person propagate any election matter to the public by holding or arranging any musical concert or any theatrical performance or any other entertainment or amusement with a view to attracting the numbers of the public thereto in any polling area.

15. **CONTROL ROOM:** In order to monitor the movement of the polling parties, to ensure peaceful conduct of the poll and counting of votes, control rooms shall be set up at the District Headquarters/Sub Division/ Block Headquarters three days before the poll and till the completion of counting. The District Election Officer (Panchayat) shall post a responsible person as an office-in-charge in the Control Room. The control room should have a telephone with E-Mail facility so that urgent messages are communicated to and from the District Headquarters and the Commission Headquarter on the day of poll. The control room shall function round the clock until the counting is completed at all level. In the Commission's Office, control room shall be in Room No.103 in the Armsdale building of the HP Secretariat. The telephone numbers viz. 2880740, 2620152, 2620159, 2620154 and fax No. 2620152 shall also remain open in the Commission's Office. You will **intimate the names of the Officers manning the control rooms with telephone numbers to the Commission also.** 

It would be desirable to have security arrangement at the Control room to meet any exigency that may arise owing to a law and order problem in the concerned district. The requirement of force at the control room shall be decided by the District Election Officer (Panchayat) in consultation with the Superintendent of Police of the District.

16. DEPUTATION OF STAFF AND PUNISHMENT ON BREACH OF OFFICIAL DUTY: Section 160-E of the Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 provides that the officer or staff employed in connection with the preparation, revision and correction of the electoral roll for, and the conduct of all elections shall be deemed to be on deputation with the State Election Commission for the period during which they are so employed and such officers and staff shall, during the period, be subject to control, and Superintendence and discipline of the State Election Commission.

- 17. SECTOR OFFICERS: The District Election Officer (Panchayat) may also examine the need for having sector officers, depending upon the geographical and general law and order conditions prevailing in the District. The Sector Officers can be provided with mobile wireless sets for transmitting urgent messages. Requirement of mobile wireless sets may be intimated to the D.I.G. (Wireless) who will be requested to provide the sets.
- 18. OBSERVERS: During the election process, Observers appointed by the State Election Commission will keep a constant watch on all issues and processes of election. The Observers will use their official vehicles in the concerned areas. The payments on account of fuels consumed will be borne by the State Election Commission. The Observers will submit the bills of fuel to the concerned District Panchayat Officers who will make the payments after following due procedure. The arrangements for stay will be made by the concerned DCs/SDMs/BDOs in the Govt. Circuit/Rest Houses. All support in terms of telephone, fax, computer, internet and Assistant for typing report will be provided by the concerned DCs/SDMs/BDOs as and when required.
- 19. TRASNSMITTING OF URGENT MESSAGES: Urgent messages may be sent through wireless in case e-mail, telephone and fax facilities are not available. The D.I.G. (Wireless) will be requested to transmit all message concerning elections on priority basis. He will also be requested to accept messages on credit.
- 20. BAN ON THE SALE OF LIQUOR: Liquor Vends shall remain closed and there shall be no sale of liquor, one day before the day of poll, on the day of poll and on the day of counting in the Panchayat areas. The dates for closing of liquor vends shall be notified by the District Election Officers (Panchayat)-cum- Deputy Commissioner in their respectively district, according to the notification of election programme.
- 21. HAND BOOKS: The detailed guidelines for RO/ARO and Presiding Officers have been given in the Hand Books. These books have already been provided to you alongwith election material.
- 22. LOGISTICS: The Commission has already fixed norms with regard to expenses on account of contingency, rehearsals or working in the odd hours in the offices etc. vide its letter No. SEC-2-23/2005-4377 dated 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2015. However, you may also authorize

RO / ARO to increase the contingency amount for cooliage etc. in case the polling party has to cover a considerable distance on foot alongwith election material. As for as diet money to polling parties is concerned, it will be paid to the polling parties and security personnel deputed with the polling party. During counting light refreshment will be provided to the staff deputed for counting, if the counting lasts till four hours or less. In case counting continues for more than four hours the staff deployed for counting will be provided lunch / dinner @ Rs. 100/- per head.

23. LUMPSUM PAYMENT:- The staff deployed on election duty may be informed that the Commission has decided to provide lumpsum payment in lieu of TA/DA on following rates:



"The Returning Officer shall fix such number of polling stations for every ward as he may deem necessary and shall publish on the date specified by the Commission in this behalf, by pasting a list thereof at his office and at the office of the Corporation showing therein clearly the polling area: Provided that no polling station shall be located in a police station, hospital or a place having sectarian or religious significance:

Provided further that as far as possible the polling station shall be located in a Government, Semi Government or Municipal buildings, and in case no such building is available, the polling station shall be located in a temporary structure."

In addition to above, the Commission issues following instructions /directions for your guidance:-

- 1. The buildings in which polling stations are being set up should be inspected by a team of two officials to be nominated by you, out of which one should be Gazetted officer.
- 2. The visiting officer will give a certificate to the effect that premises are safe, well lit and furniture arrangement is there.

3. As far as practicable polling station set up by the Election Commission of India for Legislative Assembly elections shall be kept intact in the same building with same electors in order to avoid any confusion among the electors.

4. If it appears to you that number of electors in a polling station are considerably high you may fix an auxiliary polling station. In a ward where the number of women electors is considerably high, an auxiliary polling station may be set-up for women.

5. It should be ensured that electors residing in one building are kept in the same polling station.

6. The Polling Stations are required to be classified into "Normal" or "Sensitive" keeping in view the input from the law and order machinery. The number of Polling Stations categorized as "Sensitive" may be intimated to the Commission.

Besides, it be ensured that the details of polling stations in respect of all the wards of Municipal Corporation Shimla are published on or before 15<sup>th</sup> March 2022 positively as the Commission has to start the process for preparation of electoral rolls after the details of polling stations is published.
